This year's camp theme is: Native American Heritage

Below is the Evening Program events and Daily Themes (along with some additional notes) for this year's Summer Camp for those interested in participating: **(2 pages)**

Monday: Inter-troop Fire-Building competition (led by the Camp Staff). Troops will have to use a primitive method (like flint & steel) to start their fires.

Tuesday: Native American Games Night (ran by the Scouts) and Carnival Game Expo (ran by the staff) Scouts would have to research & bring a Native American game to run if interested.

Wednesday-Family Night, OA Call out

Thursday– (usually are the camp overnights) Native American cooking competition in main camp. Camp to provide charcoal burners and fire drums. If any Scouts want to participate, make up a shopping list as we would have to purchase food in town prior to the competition. You will have to cook a Native American dish. Also Thursday night there is a selfie-scavenger hunt scheduled.

Friday– Camp-wide games, run by the S.P.L.'s., and the Closing Campfire (Scout awards, 1st year camper recognition, skits, etc.)
