What you bring to camp is what will keep you comfortable. You need enough changes of clothing to keep you clean. We'll have changes in weather; hot, cold, rainy! Be prepared! Here is a list of personal equipment you should bring. Check it carefully; change it if you see fit.

- ☐ Complete Class A Uniform **
- ☐ Warm Jacket or Sweater
- ☐ Socks
- ☐ T-Shirts (Class B t-shirts **)
- ☐ Undershorts
- ☐ Handkerchiefs / Bandanas (100% cotton)
- ☐ Swim Trunks & Towel(w/shopping bag for wet trunks)
- ☐ Shorts (**green colored)
- ☐ Tough Long Pants (for ATV, Climbing & Shop)
- ☐ Pajamas
- ☐ Camp Chair or Stool (recommended)
- ☐ 30-gal garbage bag, a few assorted ziploc bags
- ☐ Laundry Bag
- ☐ Backpack(day pack)
- ☐ Water Bottle
- ☐ Pen, Pencil, Notebook
- ☐ Ground Cloth
- ☐ Wrist Watch
- ☐ Compass
- ☐ Order of the Arrow Sash (for OA members)
- ☐ Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- ☐ Toilet Kit Containing: Soap, Deodorant, & Shampoo, Toothbrush & Paste, Comb & Brush, Towels & Washcloth, Mirror
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Scout Knife (NO SHEATH KNIVES) **(MUST HAVE EARNED TOTIN' CHIP)**
- ☐ Pillow or Air Pillow
- ☐ Insect Repellent (non-aerosol)
- ☐ Personal First Aid Kit
- ☐ Medical Form signed and dated by DOCTOR AND PARENT
- ☐ Money for Trading Post
- ☐ Cook kit with: plate/cup/bowl/knife/fork/spoon
- ☐ Materials, costumes, accessories for the theme
- ☐ Water Shoes (Old Sneakers)
- ☐ Scouts BSA Handbook (in ziploc bag)
- ☐ Camp Map (in ziploc bag)
